

- 34\* U.S. Senate Seats Currently 51D 49R
  –23D vs. 11R\* (Retiring 7D vs. 3R)
- 435 U.S. House Currently 211D 220R-4
   Vacancies

(Retiring 30D vs. 29R including 4 Chairs) (Lost Primary 2D and 2R)

\* Sen. Sasse's seat (Ricketts R-NE) special election will take place during 2024 General Election



# 2024

- 11 Governors Currently 23D 27R
  - 3D vs. 8R (Term-Limited/Retiring 3D vs. 4R)
- 162 State Executive Offices
- 5,812 State Legislative Seats
  - Senates: 851 1,109
  - Houses: 2420 2944
     (9 chambers in five states could flip 5D and 4R)
- 159 statewide ballot measures have already been certified for the '24 ballot in 41 states, 11 of which are Abortion (including in two Swing States)







#### **Biden Job Approval Since Inauguration**


Do Americans approve or disapprove of Joe Biden?





**Do Americans have a favorable or unfavorable opinion of Donald Trump?** 




# Harris' favorability jumped 11 points after becoming the presumptive nominee and now has a positive favorability rating




# **Voter's Top Priority**

# While Trump still leads on most key issues to voters, Harris has closed the gap since Biden was on the ticket in July



#### **2024 Potential Presidential – Trump Win**







#### **2024 Potential Presidential – Harris Win**




#### **2024 Harris Win Scenario**







#### **2024 Swing States/2016 Results**






### **The Money**

- As of 9/6 Harris has \$404M Cash on Hand to Trump's \$300M

Political ad spending (millions)







#### HOUSE

- The Republicans entered the Congress with a 5-seat majority
- There are only 43 competitive House seats (23 D / 20 R)
- There are 17 Republican House members in districts carried by Biden and only 5 Democrats in districts won by Trump
- The Republicans are defending 9 competitive districts in California and New York
- The Democrats are defending 7 competitive districts in Michigan, Ohio, and Pennsylvania

- Adoption of Basel III Standards
- End to some Tax Cuts

- Fewer tariffs and more Collaboration
- Increased Regulatory Scrutiny
  - ✓ Crypto under additional watch
- Control over future appointments ✓ Powell's & Barr's replacements at The Fed
- Continued Pressure on M&A
